1. Don't forget to bring muck buckets and/or wheelbarrows to Elk Hill to be able to dispose of horse manure in the bunkers provided. Special notice to all 1st June Ride participants!!!!
2. The MHC Horse Expo will be held March 7-9, 2014 at Michigan State University. Our MTRA booth will be in the Trails Room and we need volunteers to help man the booth for those three days. Carol Hyzer (989)344-2550 will be managing the schedule again this year. Please call Carol if you would like to help out and get free entrance to the Expo.
3. Don't forget to get your Recreation Passports for your vehicle license plates so that you can be "legal" on our rides. Rumor has it that the DNR will be checking those tabs more closely this year.
